<p><b>To meet the needs of online users and provide access to library materials regardless of the users' location, a Quickstart page was incorporated into the library web site. Supports SJRCC Mission Statement item 7.</b></p>	<p><b>The Quickstart page provides easy, direct access to SJRCC materials, including resources housed in the library that are searchable via the library catalog and online resources unique to SJRCC. Because the state-provided LINCCWeb portal does not provide SJRCC students quick access to SJRCC resources, it was necessary to create such a portal ourselves.</b></p>	<p><b>The in-house Quickstart pages met with great success. It was decided that all users, on campus or off-campus, should have access to this portal. While the in-house page is campus specific, the new Quickstart page that is accessible via the library web site defaults to SJRCC –all campuses. The format is the same, however, providing a familiar, standardized, SJRCC-specific interface for users whether at home or on-campus.</b></p>	<p><b>The Quickstart page has a counter that demonstrates the page's strong and ever-increasing usage.</b></p>	<p><b>The Quickstart portal will continue to be available via the library web site and publicized to students through library handouts and online course links.</b></p>
